A Workshop on the City's Transportation Master Plan Saturday April 15

The City of Ottawa has released for public input Part 1 of its Transportation Master Plan Update (TMP), reflecting the goals of the City's recently approved Official Plan (OP). The TMP is the roadmap for Ottawa's walking, cycling, transit, and vehicular networks, consistent with the new OP. Part 1 of the new TMP – now available on the City's Engage Ottawa website – includes transportation policies and actions to support Ottawa's vision and priorities.

The TMP Update will be presented to the City's Transportation Committee on April 20. This workshop is to inform the public and provide opportunities to discuss these proposed policies, and contribute to feedback on them to the City.
