The Pre-Consultation Process

An applicant must complete the following pre-consultation process with the City before applying for any of the following development applications:

- Official Plan Amendment
- Zoning By-Law Amendment
- Plan of Subdivision
- Site Plan Control



Pre-Consultation Program

The pre-consultation pilot program was developed to address concerns expressed by the public that key decisions were being made at pre-consultation meetings without their input. By allowing early public input into a proposal prior to a formal application the program aims to:

- 1. Increase transparency
- 2. Build awareness of the *Ontario Planning Act* and process



Program Wards

- The pilot project was developed for Ward 17 in 2014
- The program was expanded to the Inner Urban Area Wards 12, 13, 14, and 15 in 2017
- The program was expanded to Ward 9 in 2019



Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA)

- It is required to keep pre-consultation meetings confidential.
- Any public participant in these meetings must sign a non-disclosure agreement, acknowledging their understanding of this condition.



Role of the Community Association Representative

Community Association representatives have the unique opportunity to:

- gain clarity into the planning process
- ask questions on behalf of their community values
- provide relevant input embodying their community




